The Utah Botanical Center hosts its 4th Annual Garden Fair and Plant Sale on Saturday, August 23, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The plant sale will offer beautiful and interesting water-wise plants specially selected for Utah landscapes. The UBC staff will be available to answer questions and offer advice on plant selections.

Landscape architects Dale Torgersen and Anne Spranger will be offering advice on incorporating water-wise plants into the landscape. Bring your own plans or pictures and have them help you design with water-wise plants! A Water-wise plant package worth approx. \$200 will be given to one garden fair attendee and announced at 2:00 p.m. Prize tickets will be distributed at the Water-wise Landscape Design booth.

This year's lecture, titled *The Spirit of the Western Garden*, will feature Utah State University Extension Horticulture Specialist, Bill Varga. Mr. Varga will explore a western land ethic, highlight perceptions of the western landscape, and discuss design elements geared towards creating a western garden. Two sessions will be offered, 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. Classes are \$5 per person and limited to 40 individuals per session. Tickets can be pre-purchased at the UBC Farmer's Market on Thursday evenings from 5:00 to 8:00pm at 920 South 50 West in Kaysville or call 801 - 593-8969.
